



STRATEGIC IMPLEMENTING PARTNERS FACT SHEET Gender-Based Violence Workstream



Project Brief

Under the ACCESS **program-phase** 2, the Transcultural Psychosocial Organisation (TPO) will continue to build and strengthen the capacity of local service providers (LSPs) to provide psychosocial support for Gender-Based Violence (GBV) survivors in **five** target districts, as such: Stoeng Trang, Pouk, Krolanh, Lumphat, and O Yadav. Capacity-building activities such as training on the Minimum Standards for Basic Counselling, Psychological First Aid, and other mental health-related topics will be offered; refresher courses and coaching will be arranged to ensure knowledge and skills among local service providers. Collaboration with other implementing partners, local ethnic associations/organizations and those agencies serving persons with disabilities will strengthen responses to survivors' needs.

Project Outcomes

Project Outcome 1: The quality of psychosocial services from training, coaching and mentoring provided by local service providers to woman affected by GBV, with and without disabilities is strengthened.

Project Outcome 2: GBV survivors are effectively referred to relevant services in the target provinces.

Key Activities

- 1. To provide training on Minimum Standards for Basic Counselling and other topics related to Mental Health (MH) and GBV
- 2. To provide refresher courses and coaching/mentoring to new LSP and to train LSPs from Phase 1 to provide psychological support to survivors of GBV
- 3. Supporting a few communes to set up a model counselling rooms
- 4. Awareness raising/ Psychoeducation in communities on GBV and its impacts on the mental health of survivors, how to identify survivors who need help, and services available for GBV survivors.
- 5. Psychological and Psychiatric treatment provided by LSP and Project staff to GBV survivors: face-to-face or remoted service.





6. Meeting to advocate on improvement of psychosocial services for GBV survivors: such as Technical Working Group on GBV, GBV net-work meeting (provincial, district level), 16 days campaign to end violence against women and girls and Provincial Executive committee meeting.

Beneficiaries

- 180 new LSPs will training on the Minimum Standards for Basic Counselling, GBV, and basic mental health.
- 500 Women and girls affected by GBV have received social support services.
- 1000 GBV survivors participated in community awareness raising and access information on mental health and other services.

Kompong Cham province: Stoeng Trang District

• Seam Reap Province: Pouk and Krolanh District

• Ratanakiri Province: Lumphat and O Yadav District
