WHAT ACCESS 2 DOES IN KAMPONG CHAM

ACCESS 2 works in Kampong Cham to strengthen access to coordinated and inclusive services so survivors of gender-based violence (GBV) and persons with disabilities receive timely, quality support aligned with national priorities. Australia's support connects provincial departments, health services and civil society across all three of the program's workstreams in the province.

Coordination underpins this progress. The Provincial Coordination Committee brings sub-national authorities and implementing partners around one table, while the Provincial Disability Action Council and GBV Response Working Groups carry national plans into districts and communes. Strengthened referral pathways now link commune GBV counselling rooms, district working groups and services at the provincial referral hospital.

The province shows what sustained engagement delivers. Its One Stop Service Unit for GBV Survivors hosts study visits from other provinces, persons with disabilities now sit on commune committees across the province and physiotherapy (PT) services are expanding at the provincial referral hospital.

ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS IN KAMPONG CHAM

Gender-Based Violence



- Supporting 7 GBV Response Working Groups (1 provincial, 6 district) and training 271 members on counselling, referral and legal support
- Expanding confidential GBV counselling rooms at commune halls, with 10 operating
- Providing support to 441 GBV cases with 888 services

Disability Inclusion



- Supporting disability identification across the province, with 19,116 people assessed and 14,624 receiving disability cards
- Registering 3,304 persons with disabilities for Family Package social protection
- Supporting the appointment of 125 persons with disabilities to Commune Committees for Women and Children (CCWC) in 109 communes

Rehabilitation



- Supporting the new purpose-built physiotherapy unit at the provincial referral hospital, providing rehabilitation services to 1,957 clients since its launch in June 2025



ACCESS 2 has strengthened disability-inclusive and GBV-responsive planning and budgeting in Kampong Cham, ensuring that the needs of vulnerable groups are reflected in local development plans, investments, and essential services.

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
